COUNCIL REPORT – Monday, July 9, 2018

- The church's ADMIN Council met on Monday and with John D focused our devotions time on Acts 16:1-10 which teaches us to seek God's direction in our decision making and to be prepared to change direction when opportunities arise – the Lord promises to equip us.
- Our Classis BCNW advisor pastor, Rev. Curtis Korver was welcomed for this meeting of Council.
- The ballot counting committee reported the results of counting votes collected and submitted re seeking approval to extend a CALL to Pastors Ed and Michelle Top of Calgary, AB. Total of votes counted was 115, with 70.5% approving. Pastors were informed by telephone and told that a Letter of Call will be coming to them soon.
- Joe W reported that diaconal support/encouragement for the Syrian refugee family continues and they will be discussing with them whether rental of their first home in Canada should continue for another year or be changed to monthly rental.
- In the coming months, Council will be seeking nominees to fill vacancies left by 2 retiring elders (Jim B, Gerald W) and 2 retiring deacons (Deen K, Joe W). Please inform the office or a council member with suggestions.
- Members of Duncan Pentecostal Church have requested whether there may be ways for our church to share worship space of our building. The building is the Lord's – not ours? Please share any ideas with Jim or Deen.
- Next meeting of the ADMIN Council is scheduled for Aug. 27, 2018.
