The Offering is for Church Ministries and (Teen Challenge - label cheque & envelope). Adult & Teen Challenge BC is a faith-based restoration program for men and women, ages 19 and older, who are trapped in addiction. The program is residential in nature and is usually completed in 12 months. There are three locations across British Columbia, in Chilliwack, Okanagan, and Abbotsford (2 for men and 1 for women).

The organization of Teen Challenge originally began in 1958 on the streets of New York City. A pastor named Reverend David Wilkerson was burdened to help teens involved with gangs and drugs begin a new life in Jesus Christ. The ministry of Teen Challenge came to Vancouver in 1965, and was later re-launched as "Teen Challenge BC" in the year 2000. www.teenchallengebc.com
