The Search Team has been extremely busy these past few months, meeting weekly and sometimes twice during the week. After having listened to many sermons, interviews via skype, and many discussions we have decided thoughtfully and prayerfully to extend invitation to **Ed and Michelle T**, both ordained pastors, to come to Duncan for a visit. They accepted our invitation as you have read in the bulletin. Both Ed and Michelle are children of CRC pastors. Ed was a journalist for several years. They are both former Christian school teachers. Michelle is also a licensed counselor. They have 3 teenaged children. Both are very community minded and involve themselves in community activities. They have special interest in sports, music, and drama.

Pastor Search Team continued:

Ed and Michelle plan to arrive some time on **Thursday, May 24** and will meet with the Search Team that evening for a more personal interview. On **Friday, May 25** they will meet with full council in the evening. On **Saturday evening, May 26**, we will have a dessert/coffee social where the congregation will have an opportunity to meet and greet Ed and Michelle. They will briefly introduce themselves to the congregation and then a discussion ensue over coffee. Hopefully there will be ample time for questions.
